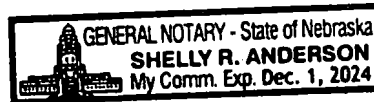

ORDER TO PRODUCE IDENTIFYING  
PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

TO: Kevin Meyer, and other law enforcement officers of the Lincoln Police Department.




WHEREAS, Kevin Meyer has filed an Affidavit before the undersigned Judge of the County Court of Lancaster County, Nebraska, a copy of which Affidavit is attached hereto and made a part hereof, the court finds that for purposes of this Order the facts set forth in said Affidavit are true, and said facts and the evidence adduced constitute grounds and probable cause for the issuance of an Order to Produce Identifying Physical Characteristics. The Court further finds and orders as follows:

1. That the offense of Possession of a Deadly Weapon by a Prohibited Person is the subject of said Affidavit referred to above
2. That there is probable cause to believe that the offense of Possession of a Deadly Weapon by a Prohibited Person has been committed.
3. That there is probable cause to believe that Jamael Mims committed said offense.
4. That Identifying Physical Characteristics Sought are DNA Buccal swabs
5. That Jamael Mims has refused, or there is reason to believe that Jamael Mims will refuse, to voluntarily provide the identifying physical characteristics sought.
6. That Jamael Mims is the individual who may be detained for obtaining such identifying physical characteristics.
7. That Investigator Meyer and other officers of the Lincoln Police Department are the peace officers authorized to obtain such identifying physical characteristics and to effectuate any detention which may be necessary to obtain the same.

8. That Jamael Mims will be under no legal obligation to submit to any interrogation or to make any statement during the period of his appearance.
9. That such identifying physical characteristics may be obtained at the Lancaster County Jail, 3801 West O Street, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.
10. That Jamael Mims shall appear at the Lancaster County Jail, 3801 West O Street, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, at such date and time as is designated by Investigator Meyer for the purpose of obtaining the above-mentioned identifying physical characteristics.
11. That if Jamael Mims fails to comply with the request of said Investigator Meyer, the said Jamael Mims shall be guilty of contempt of court and be punished accordingly.
12. That Jamael Mims shall be required to stay no longer than one (1) hour for the purpose of Investigator Meyer obtaining the above-mentioned identifying physical characteristics.
13. That this Order shall remain in force and effect for a period of fifteen (15) days only.
14. That a copy of this Order shall be served upon Jamael Mims.
15. That a Return of this Order shall be made within 30 days after the identification procedures have been carried out, setting forth the type of identifying physical characteristics obtained. If the Order is not executed, a Return shall be filed within 30 days stating the same.

THEREFORE, you are commanded to search the said Jamael Mims to produce the aforementioned identifying physical characteristics which constitutes evidence that a criminal offense has been committed, and to seize the same.

AFFIDAVIT FOR  
ORDER TO PRODUCE IDENTIFYING  
PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

COMES NOW, Investigator Meyer of the Lincoln Police Department ,  
being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and states as follows:

1. Your AFFIANT was assigned to investigate Possession of a Deadly  
Weapon by a Prohibited Person that occurred at 557 West Butler Avenue,  
Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

2. Your AFFIANT has reviewed reports of other peace officers involved  
in the investigation of Possession of a Deadly Weapon by a Prohibited Person and  
has conducted additional follow up into the investigation of the incident.  
According to the information that your AFFIANT obtained:

On 09-13-2023, while monitoring Jamael Mims' (08-06-2002) social media  
accounts, investigators observed him to post a video on his Instagram page. This  
video started with the camera pointing at himself and his face is clearly visible. It  
is clear in the video that he was standing in the driveway of 557 West Butler  
Avenue, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. Mims was observed to be holding  
a black AR-style rifle and pointing it at the camera. The video continues with  
Mims carrying the rifle around outside. It should be noted that this is a densely  
populated neighborhood with numerous houses within close proximity to each  
other. Mims then walked inside the residence where he then picked up a second  
firearm. This firearm was a camouflaged shotgun that he held up to the camera.  
At this point in the video he appeared to be talking with another party. He cycled  
the shotgun by racking the charging handle to show the other party that it was a  
real firearm.

On 09-15-2023, Investigator Meyer authored a search warrant for 557 West Butler in reference to the aforementioned video and other evidence that investigators had collected. The warrant was signed by a Lancaster County Court Judge.

On 09-15-2023 at approximately 1430 hours, investigators with the Lincoln Police Department approached the residence in order to serve the search warrant. Investigators had received information that Mims and William Smith (05-28-1987) were both in the residence. As investigators approached the residence, Mims was observed on the front porch and ran back inside. As investigators began giving loud verbal commands to the occupants of the residence, Mims was observed to run out of the back door of the trailer carrying a rifle in his hands. Mims ran to the east and as investigators pursued, they could hear Mims charging the rifle as he ran as if to prepare to shoot it. Mims ran from the area and a perimeter was set up. An extensive search was conducted but Mims was not located.

Investigators searched the path where Mims ran and located a Mossberg .22 caliber rifle. This rifle appeared identical to the rifle that Mims posted in the video on 09-13-2023. Investigators also located a second firearm along the same path which was a Taurus Millennium G2 9mm handgun. This handgun appeared identical to a firearm that Mims has posted on social media with in the past.

During a search of the residence, several parties were located inside including Smith. While searching the residence, investigators located a Franchi Affinity 12 gauge shotgun hidden under the couch. This shotgun appeared identical to the shotgun Mims had posted on his video on 09-13-2023. This shotgun was found to have been stolen 4 days prior under Lincoln Police Department case C3-081432.

Smith was found to be a prohibited person and was lodged. During a Miranda interview, Smith stated that he has seen Mims in possession of a black handgun in the past.

Mims is a convicted felon stemming from a 2022 conviction of Possession of a Firearm by a Prohibited Juvenile Offender, which prohibits him from legally possessing firearms.

3. Your AFFIANT knows that buccal DNA swabs are a way of producing

non-testimonial identification evidence regarding the person responsible for Possession of a Deadly Weapon by a Prohibited Person described herein. The identifying physical characteristics sought from Jamael Mims is a sample of his/her DNA in the form of DNA buccal swabs. The procurement of these identifying physical characteristics is likely to contribute evidence to the further identification of Jamael Mims as being the person responsible for Possession of a Deadly Weapon by a Prohibited Person herein.

The identifying physical characteristics sought can be obtained from Jamael Mims at the Lancaster County Jail, 3801 West O Street, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska and should require a detention not to exceed one (1) hour.

AFFIANT further states that there is probable cause to believe that Jamael Mims is responsible for Possession of a Deadly Weapon by a Prohibited Person as described herein, and in violation of the laws of the State of Nebraska.

4. Your AFFIANT has been advised by Jamael Mims's attorney that Jamael Mims has refused to voluntarily provide a DNA sample via buccal swabs.

Further your affiant saith not.
