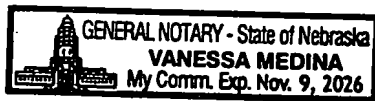

WHEREAS, Brian Gruber, has filed an Affidavit before the undersigned Judge of the County Court of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, and said written Affidavit, having been duly considered, the court finds that the facts set forth in said Affidavit are true, and that those facts do constitute grounds and probable cause for the issuance of a Search Warrant.

THEREFORE, you are commanded to search a Go Pro Camera System and storage device which is located in the Lincoln Police Department Property Unit in Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska under property report Q2403593 Lancaster County, Nebraska, for the following items from 02-24-2024 at 0700 hours to 02-24-2024 at 2359 hours:

Investigator Brian Gruber #1856, being first duly sworn upon oath deposes and states that he is a Investigator for the Lincoln Police Department, Lancaster County, Nebraska. AFFIANT further states he is currently involved in the investigation of Felony Operate Motor Vehicle to Avoid Arrest 28-905 (3) (F4), occurring in the city of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. As part of the investigation, AFFIANT has consulted with other involved law enforcement and reviewed case reports. AFFIANT states as follows:

Facts:

On 02-24-2024 at 2000 hours, your Affiant was operating as a Tactical Flight Officer for the Nebraska State Patrol Aviation Support Unit. While operating as a Tactical Flight Officer, your Affiant observed a dirt bike driving recklessly and at a high rate of speed on O Street east of 30th Street in Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. Your Affiant observed the vehicle continue to drive at a high rate of speed and called for a marked unit to assist. Lincoln Police Officer Bond #1922 assisted and attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the dirt bike as it was turning northbound onto Antelope Parkway from Q Street. While the dirt bike was approaching Vine Street on Antelope Valley Parkway, Officer Bond engaged the overhead lights on a marked police cruiser to initial a traffic stop for the reckless driving behavior. The dirt bike operator ignored the overhead lights and continued to swerve around multiple stopped vehicles in the northbound lanes on Antelope Valley Parkway. The dirt bike then made a right turn eastbound onto Vine Street from Antelope Valley Parkway from the through lane where a posted, 'NO TURN ON RED', sign was visible/posted. Officer Bond immediately terminated the overhead lights as it was clear the dirt bike was fleeing.

Your Affiant continued to conduct surveillance on the dirt bike and maintained a visual from the air. Your Affiant observed the vehicle to continue driving recklessly through the city of Lincoln nearly causing accidents while driving in a reckless manner. Your Affiant also observed the vehicle leave the roadways several times and drive on sidewalks. Eventually, your Affiant observed

the dirt bike come to a stop near the intersection of W Cornhusker/W Adams Street to the south and west under a bridge. Officers with the Lincoln Police Department and Nebraska State Patrol Troopers were able to take the occupant of the dirt bike into custody. He was identified as Tyler Reinhardt (09-19-2007) and was transported to the Youth Attention Center by Officer Walters 1885. Tyler was lodged in the Youth Services Center per Juvenile Probation for the Operate a Motor Vehicle to Avoid Arrest.

Your Affiant is aware that as Tyler was taken into custody, he was wearing a helmet which was equipped with a Go Pro Camera. Your Affiant is aware that the Go Pro Camera indicated that it was recording at the time of Tyler's arrest and had been recording for one and a half hours. Your Affiant believes that evidence of this crime of fleeing to avoid will be located on the Go Pro Camera and/or the storage device the camera utilizes to store videos. Your Affiant is aware that the arresting officers seized the camera and helmet, and placed them in LPD Property Unit under property report number Q2403593. Your Affiant states that probable cause exists to search the Go Pro Camera and storage device in the camera for video evidence of this offense which occurred on 02-24-2024. Your Affiant states that probable cause exists to search the device from the date and time range 02-24-2024 at 0700 hours to 2359 hours on 02-24-2024.

The above does constitute grounds of probable cause for the issuance of a Search Warrant for a Go Pro Camera System and storage device which is located in the Lincoln Police Department Property Unit in Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska under property report Q2403593, for the following items:

Electronic Photographs

Electronic Audio
