COMES NOW: Officer Payton Hyland with the Lincoln Police Department, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and states as follows:

1. Your AFFIANT is a full-time certified law enforcement official in the State of Nebraska. As part of that certification, your AFFIANT received instruction on driving under the influence investigations, including, but not limited to: intoxicated persons' driving behavior; physical signs of intoxication; administration of Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, including the horizontal gaze nystagmus, walk and turn, one leg stand, and wet lab; and administering preliminary breath tests.
2. Your AFFIANT was working in their official capacity as a law enforcement official on 04-24-2024 at 2143 hours and during that time, your AFFIANT contacted the suspect, Alexis E. Stoyan, whose date of birth is 11-15-2006 Your AFFIANT believes that probable cause exists to believe that said suspect was operating or in the actual physical control of a motor vehicle on a public highway or private property open to public access while under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs for the following reason(s): Alexis was contacted following being involved in a rollover accident just west of the intersection of 33rd and O Street, where Alexis reportedly was passing a vehicle and contacted the rear of it, causing

that vehicle to roll several times. Upon speaking with Alexis, she smelled heavily of alcohol and initially denied any alcohol use. Alexis stated she was operating a motor vehicle as the sole occupant and was passing the other involved vehicle and accidentally "clipped" it. A witness, Mckenna A. O'Connell, 01-18-2005 reported observing Alexis consuming alcohol prior to the accident, who estimated Alexis's vehicle was traveling approximately 70 mph. Alexis later admitted to consuming two shots of alcohol while at the hospital to her mother.

3. Upon contact, your AFFIANT noticed during their investigation, or was informed that said suspect exhibited the following signs of intoxication:
Odor of alcohol, Bloodshot eyes, Watery eyes, Slurred speech, Admission of alcohol consumption, vehicle accident.
4. Your AFFIANT Administered field sobriety test and said suspect showed signs of impairment
5. At the conclusion of the field sobriety test, your AFFIANT:
Administered a preliminary breath test and said suspect had a result of .161 grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath.
6. Your AFFIANT believes that the suspect was under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs at the time he/she was operating or in the physical control of a motor vehicle.
7. Your AFFIANT is now seeking a search warrant for the procurement of a blood sample and to authorize a qualified individual, as identified by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 60-6,201, to withdraw a sample(s) of said suspect's blood pursuant to Nebraska

law for purposes of formal chemical testing of his/her blood to determine the concentration of alcohol and/or drugs.

8. Your AFFIANT believes, or has reason to believe, that the suspect will refuse, has refused, or will be unable to voluntarily provide a sample of his or her blood for the following reasons: Refused consent.
9. Your AFFIANT requests permission to detain the suspect, if necessary, for a period not to exceed five (5) hours, and to use reasonable force under the circumstances, in order to accomplish the authorized purposes of the warrant.
10. Your AFFIANT knows Alexis E. Stoyan is currently located at ****Bryan Medical Center West Campus** located at 2300 S. 16th Street, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. And is under the supervision of medical staff and/or law enforcement. Your AFFIANT requests permission to serve this warrant at ****Bryan Medical Center West Campus** located at 2300 S. 16th Street, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, or wherever the suspect may be found.
11. Your AFFIANT states that the public interest requires that the requested warrant be served at any time and as expeditiously as possible for the reason that the human body constantly metabolizes alcohol and/or drugs and evidence of the crime will be destroyed with any delay in the sample collection process.

Your AFFIANT says that all the information contained in this Affidavit occurred in Lancaster County, Nebraska.
