





Chris Milisits, being first duly sworn upon oath deposes and states that he is a Investigator for the Lincoln Police Department, Lancaster County, Nebraska. AFFIANT further states he is currently involved in the investigation of Fleeing to Avoid Arrest, Criminal Mischief and Willful Reckless Driving, occurring at 19<sup>th</sup> Street and Knox Street, Lancaster County, Nebraska. As part of the investigation, AFFIANT has consulted with other involved law enforcement and reviewed case reports. AFFIANT states as follows:

**Facts:**

On Sunday 12-17-23, at approximately 0939 hours, Officer Kernan was on patrol and conducted a traffic stop by activating the overhead lights on his marked cruiser. The violator vehicle he was attempting to stop was a white Hyundai Azera with no license plates. The traffic stop was initiated in the area of 19<sup>th</sup>/Knox Streets in Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. The offender vehicle stopped in a parking stall at the Willow Apartment Complex. Prior to officer Kernan making contact with the driver, the vehicle fled in a NB direction in the parking lot squealing the tires as it accelerated. Officer Kernan followed the vehicle which came to a dead end. The white Hyundai backed up quickly causing the vehicle to travel over the top of a retaining wall where it struck the top of a parked vehicle that was parked in an adjacent apartment complex below the retaining wall. The vehicle that was struck during the reckless flight to avoid arrest sustained significant damage but is valued at less than \$5,000. It is described as a Grey 2008 Nissan Rouge and sustained approximately \$2,500 damage.

Officer Kernan exited his cruiser drawing his firearm and began to approach the offender vehicle. While approaching the vehicle, the suspect accelerated quickly squealing the tires and going forward in the direction of Officer Kernan. Officer Kernan fired two shots from his handgun at the vehicle as it accelerated toward him. The vehicle then struck a large landscaping rock next to Officer Kernan's cruiser before fleeing the area without being located.

Investigators used the in-car camera from Kernan's cruiser to identify the make and model of the vehicle. There were also unique markings on the suspect vehicle that would help identify it. On 12-17-23, at 2213 hours Officer Covault located the suspect vehicle parked Manatt Street between 8<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> Streets with nobody inside. The vehicle was identified as the suspect vehicle and had in-transit tags in the window showing it was purchased at George's Auto and the purchaser's name listed as B. Blazio.

Officers obtained surveillance video from a couple houses along Manatt St showing the suspect vehicle parking there approximately 2-3 minutes after it fled the traffic stop. The driver is seen exiting the vehicle approximately 15 minutes later and running towards another vehicle that arrived in the area to pick him up. Affiant has reason to believe that due to the short amount of time between the suspect fleeing, arriving on Manatt St, and being picked up by another vehicle that the suspect would have had to communicate with other persons to assist him in avoiding apprehension. Based upon affiant's training and experience, law enforcement has reason to believe that the suspect would have used an electronic device to communicate with the person or persons who picked him up.

The suspect was a male wearing red shorts, black T-shirt and black slides. The suspect was also wearing his hair tied up in a bun in the back. The suspect vehicle was towed to the impound lot located at 101 Charleston St., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska and his being held as evidence. Officers located two bullet holes in the hood of the vehicle and damage to the back driver side where it collided with the parked vehicle which confirms this was the same vehicle that fled from Officer Kernan. Additionally, your Affiant knows through training and experience and consultation with a law enforcement accident reconstructionist that motor vehicles can record electronic data including, but not limited to, crash impact speeds, throttle, braking, engine RPM, and other data regarding the operation and performance of a specific vehicle. This electronic data can be used to better understand what occurred during a collision event. This electronic data can be housed in a module on the vehicle itself.

During further investigation, officers determined the vehicle was purchased by Braulio Blazio on 12-09-23 from George's Auto located at 1500 Cornhusker Highway, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. Video surveillance was obtained from George's and shows Braulio Blazio with his hair tied up in a bun in the back also wearing black sides that are seen on the suspect. Braulio Blazio is seen wearing a black Slipknot t-shirt and dark colored long pants.

The above does constitute grounds of probable cause for the issuance of a Search Warrant for a white 2006 Hyundai Azera with no license plates, VIN



KMHFC46F26A054421. The vehicle is located at Capital Towing 101 Charleston St., Lancaster County, Nebraska, for the following items:

Any identification including proof of ownership, DNA swabs, fingerprints, cellular telephones or other electronic devices capable of providing location data or communicating with other electronic devices, cameras, any electronically recorded crash data or event data recorder and the module in which it is housed which may be capable of providing pre-crash or crash data, bullets or bullet fragments, hairs, and fibers. Your AFFIANT seeks authorization to measure, photograph, video tape and seize the aforementioned items.
