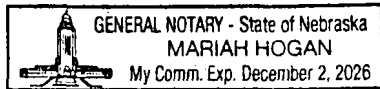

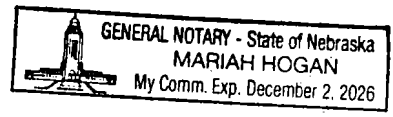



**AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH
WARRANT FOR BLOOD**

COMES NOW: Deputy Sheriff Paige Uzzell 902196 with the Lancaster County Sheriff's Office, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and states as follows:

1. Your AFFIANT is a full-time certified law enforcement official in the State of Nebraska. As part of that certification, your AFFIANT received instruction on driving under the influence investigations, including, but not limited to: intoxicated persons' driving behavior; physical signs of intoxication; administration of Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, including the horizontal gaze nystagmus, nine step walk and turn, one leg stand, and wet labs; and administering preliminary breath tests.
2. Your AFFIANT was working in their official capacity as a law enforcement official on December 23rd, at 0145hrs and during that time, your AFFIANT contacted the suspect, Kevin J. Tejada-Morales, whose date of birth is 01-19-2001. Your AFFIANT believes that probable cause exists to believe that said suspect was operating or in the actual physical control of a motor vehicle on a public highway or private property open to public access while under the influence of alcohol or drugs for the following reason(s)

Kevin J. Tejada-Morales was the driver and sole occupant involved in a single vehicle motor vehicle crash, which resulted in serious injury to himself. The vehicle was located on Davy Rd, just west of 14th St. The vehicle was observed flipped over with both of its driver side tires broken off. The vehicle items were scattered to the east of the vehicle's resting position. The vehicle items were scattered along approximately 100 meters. Tejada-Morales was observed ejected from the vehicle, lying approximately 150 meters to the east of the rolled vehicle.

Numerous Coor Light beer cans and bottles were located among the vehicle debris. Two Busch Beer cans were located just west of the vehicle. An empty box of Coor Light beer bottles and an empty box of Coor Light beer cans were located in the vehicle. Witnesses stated that Tejeda-Morales was the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle. The vehicle was located by Davy bartenders who stated that they had observed Tejeda-Morales extremely intoxicated at the Davy bar. They attempted to prevent Tejeda-Morales from driving the vehicle away from the bar but were ultimately unsuccessful. They had offered to give Tejeda-Morales a ride home, but he refused and left alone.

3. Upon contact, your AFFIANT noticed during their investigation, or was informed by other law enforcement officer(s) or emergency responder(s), that said suspect exhibited the following signs of intoxication:
The odor of an alcoholic beverage could be detected emitting from Tejeda-Morales' person by law enforcement and emergency responders. No other obvious signs of impairment were observed due to the extent of Tejeda-Morales' injuries.
4. Your AFFIANT did not administer Standardized Field Sobriety Tests due to the extent of Tejeda-Morales' injuries.
5. Your AFFIANT did not attempt a preliminary breath test due to the extent of Tejeda-Morales' injuries.
6. Your AFFIANT believes that the suspect was under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs at the time he/she was operating or in actual physical control of a motor vehicle and detained the suspect.
7. Your AFFIANT verified that a sample of blood was procured and that a qualified individual, as identified by *Neb. Rev. Stat. § 60-6,201*, withdrew a sample(s) of said suspect's blood pursuant to Nebraska law for purposes of formal chemical testing of his/her blood to determine the concentration of alcohol and/or drugs.
8. Your AFFIANT believes, or has reason to believe, that the suspect will refuse, has refused, or will be unable to voluntarily provide a sample his or her blood for the following reasons: Due to the extent of Tejeda-Morales'


injuries. Tejeda-Morales was also uncooperative during initial contact.

9. Your AFFIANT requests permission to detain the suspect and restrain the suspect, if necessary, for a period not to exceed five (5) hours, and to use reasonable force under the circumstances, to accomplish the authorized purposes of the warrant.
10. Your AFFIANT requests permission to serve this warrant at Bryan West Emergency Room, a detention facility, or wherever the suspect may be found.
11. Your AFFIANT states that the public interest requires that the requested warrant be served at any time and as expeditiously as possible for the reason that the human body constantly metabolizes alcohol and/or drugs and evidence of the crime will be destroyed with any delay in the sample collection process.


