



Matthew Buhrman, being first duly sworn upon oath deposes and states that he is an Investigator for the Lincoln Police Department, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. AFFIANT states he is currently involved in the investigation of a Theft by Receiving \$5000/More 28-517, occurring on April 11, 2024,, at 1040 Y Street, Lincoln, Lancaster County Nebraska. AFFIANT has reviewed case reports regarding this investigation prepared by other involved Law Enforcement Officers.

Affiant's Background

Your affiant has been a police officer for the Lincoln Police Department since 2018. Since 2018 Affiant has been investigating misdemeanor and felony crimes with the Lincoln Police Department to include homicide, burglary, robbery, assault, weapon offences, narcotics, sexual assault, human trafficking, and pornography. Your Affiant has training and experience in conducting criminal investigations.

This Affidavit is submitted in support of a search warrant. Since this Affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of securing a search warrant, your Affiant not set forth every fact known to me regarding this investigation. The statements contained in this Affidavit are based in part on the investigation that your Affiant has conducted, and information provided to your Affiant by other law enforcement officers verbally, and through written reports.

Case Facts

On April 10, 2024, at approximately 0722 hours, Officer Fisher #1684 with the Lincoln Police Department was dispatched to a belated stolen vehicle located at 5530 Grouse Place. Mark McDonald reported that his silver 2007 Lexus RX Sports Utility Vehicle (SUV) with Nebraska License Plates AFX218 (VIN: JTJHW31UX72016867) had been stolen from the driveway of his residence that same morning between 0630 and 0700 hours. Mark McDonald advised that his daughter, Morgan McDonald, was the primary operator of the vehicle.

On April 11, 2024, Illiana Maxwell reported that she observed a silver Lexus

SUV stuck on the railroad tracks located just south of 1040 Y Street. Maxwell reported that it appeared that the silver Lexus SUV was attempting to continue driving, however it was unable to move. Maxwell stated that she then observed a black male wearing a blue sweatshirt and white shorts, exit the driver's seat and flee the area on foot. Lincoln Police Officers arrived on location and observed that the silver SUV on the railroad tracks was the stolen silver 2007 Lexus RX SUV with Nebraska License Plates AFX218.

Your AFFIANT observed a black male matching the description of the suspect in the area of Transformation Drive and North Antelope Valley Parkway. The male was contacted and identified as Lamont Stuart (DOB: 02-13-1982). Lincoln Police Officers located a 7 Brew Coffee gift card that belonged to Morgan McDonald in Stuart's wallet. Stuart was placed into custody and was transported to the Lincoln Police Headquarters located at 575 South 10th Street for an interview as he had previously waived Miranda and agreed to make a statement. During the questioning, Stuart advised that he didn't have a phone, as he had broken his previous phone and threw it out the window of a moving vehicle.

Lincoln Police Department Officers continued to search the recovered stolen Lexus SUV and located a black and red Samsung phone on the ground near the left side of the driver's seat. Lincoln Police Officers contacted Mark and Morgan McDonald regarding the ownership of the black and red Samsung phone. Morgan McDonald denied owning the phone and did not know who the current owner of the phone was.

Between the dates of April 5, 2024 and April 10, 2024, Stuart has been involved with multiple larcenies from autos, vandalisms, and a burglary in the area of South 56th Street to South 70th Street, between Pine Lake Road and Yankee Hill Road. The black and red Samsung phone was not reported stolen by any of the victims of these criminal offenses.

The black and red Samsung phone that was located in the 2007 Lexus RX SUV with Nebraska License Plates AFX218 was obtained and placed into the Lincoln Police Department Property Unit under property report Q2407342. The owner of the phone is unknown.

Digital Device Identification

Through your Affiant's training and experience with examining digital devices, your Affiant is aware cellular devices contain multiple device identifiers to include, an Integrated Circuit Card which has an Integrated Circuit Card ID number ("ICCID"), this ICCID is the serial number of the device's SIM card. The SIM card generally contains

the Mobile Station Integrated Services Digital Network Number (MSISDN) also referred to as the phone number utilized by the device. The telephone number of a user's device can be linked to the carrier or provider of service for the device along with secondary providers such as Apple and or Google. Digital devices also contain other device identifiers, including the Media Access Control address ("MAC address"), the unique device identifier ("UDID"), serial numbers, an International Mobile Subscriber Identity ("IMSI") and International Mobile Equipment Identification ("IMEI"). These identifiers are utilized in varying capacity for identification of the device and for access and use of service providers, and third-party applications.

The accessing of a device for multiple device identifiers is not unlike that of access the interior of a motor vehicle to identify the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN). The information identified from the multiple device identifiers is also analogous to the search for "indicia of occupancy" while executing a search warrant at a residence and will aid in the identification of the user and or operator of the device. Therefore, the records requested in this warrant are likely to contain the identifiers required to identify owner, users, and/or service providers utilized by the device.

Your Affiant requests authorization to search for and seize the listed items in Attachment B, hereby attached and incorporated by reference.
