Joseph Gallagher, being first duly sworn upon oath deposes and states that he is a Police Officer for the Lincoln Police Department, Lancaster County, Nebraska. AFFIANT further states he is currently involved in the investigation of Domestic Assault – 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree (28-323), occurring at 4210 South 33<sup>rd</sup> Street, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. As part of the investigation, AFFIANT has consulted with other involved law enforcement and reviewed case reports.

Consulted with other involved law enforcement and reviewed case reports.

AFFIANT states as follows:

Facts:

On 04-21-2024 at 2010 hours, your Affiant was dispatched to 1505 Consulted to 1505 reported his roommate, Sally Vongphakdy, was assaulted earlier in the day by her boyfriend, Michael Wade. Sally was also present at 1505 Superior Street #5. Your  $^{\infty}$ Affiant observed several injuries on Sally's person, to include bruising and swelling to her left eye; scratches and lacerations to her left chest and neck area; and dark bruising to her right upper arm and forearm. Sally reported she was in two physical altercations with Michael earlier in the day on 04-21-2024.

Sally stated the first altercation occurred at approximately 1000 hours at their shared residence, 5551 Lowell Avenue. Sally stated she was cleaning up food in the kitchen and Michael became upset at her for throwing away food and struck her once in the back of the head with an open hand. Sally stated she then went to her salon at 4210 South 33rd Street, Lincoln Nebraska. Sally stated Michael showed up shortly after. Sally stated Michael again became physical with her and began grabbing at her and scratching her. Sally stated she attempted to block Michael from grabbing at her, and during the altercation sustained the previously mentioned injuries.

Sally stated she owns and keeps a firearm at their shared residence, 5551 Lowell Avenue, and Michael is a convicted felon. Your Affiant confirmed Michael has a felony conviction and is prohibited from possessing a firearm. Sally told your Affiant, that Michael previously took the firearm from her, and placed it under their bed, in their shared bedroom at 5551 Lowell Street, Lincoln Nebraska.

Officers attempted to contact Michael at his residence, 5551 Lowell Avenue, both by knocking at his bedroom door and announcing themselves but were unsuccessful. When officers arrived at 5551 Lowell Avenue, Tony was on location and let officers inside. Tony stated Michael was inside his bedroom and Tony directed officers to a bedroom on the South side of the residence. There was an officer watching the exterior of the house and the officer observed Michael's bedroom light turn off as officers were making announcements.

Sally told your Affiant she and Michael have been in a dating relationship for approximately three to four years. Sally told your Affiant, Michael has been physically abusive to her throughout their relationship. Through researching the Lincoln Police Department's record management system, Michael was found to have a recent arrest for Domestic Assault against Sally on 03-27-2024.

Officers surrounded Michael's residence, 5551 Lowell Avenue, and yelled verbal commands for Michael to surrender. At approximately 2342 hours, Michael exited the residence, and he was taken into custody by officers. Michael did not have possession of the firearm at the time of his arrest, leading officers to believe the firearm was still inside the residence, 5551 Lowell Avenue.

Your Affiant states that it is approximately 1205 a.m. at the time that this Affidavit for Search Warrant is being drafted.
