On May 10, 2024, Trooper Jordan Dostal #481 was on duty, in uniform, wearing the badge of office, and in a marked patrol unit in Lancaster County, Nebraska.

At approximately 2134 hours, Trooper Dostal observed a silver Ford Fusion driving with out its lights on near 48th and Cornhusker heading eastbound. Trooper Dostal turned around on the vehicle and lost visual of it. Trooper Dostal observed a motorcyclist wave his hand at Trooper Dostal to stop near Havelock and Cornhusker. The motorcyclist said he continued straight and believed the individual was driving while intoxicated.

Trooper Dostal observed the vehicle near 84th and Cornhusker continuing eastbound. Trooper Dostal observed the vehicle to fail to stay in its lane. Trooper Dostal activated his emergency lights and the driver accelerated the vehicle fleeing from Trooper Dostal's traffic stop.

NSP helicopter stated over the radio that they had it and were following it with the camera system. NSP helicopter observed the vehicle come to a stop at 321 Haverford Dr.

Trooper Dostal arrested the driver, MOHAMMAD SAAD JAWAD ALHASAN (DOB: 10/25/1999). Trooper Dostal smelled the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from Alhasan. Alhasan was transported to Bryan West Hospital (BWH).

Trooper Dostal read Alhasan the Post Chemical Test Advisement Form to submit to a blood draw. Alhasan stated to Trooper Dostal, no. Trooper Dostal read the form at 2305 hours.

Trooper Dostal filled out a search warrant for Alhasan's blood and was signed. Trooper Dostal arrived back to BWH with the signed warrant. Trooper Dostal read subsection (3) of the Post Chemical Test Advisement Form at 0011 hours and showed the copy of the signed warrant to Alhasan. Alhasan stated that he would not submit to a blood draw. Trooper Dostal cited Alhasan for refusal.
