for documentation purposes a female identified as Leslie Brown exited the home demanding to know why he was photographing their property. Brian Brown then exited the home and began cursing at him while he was attempting to explain the violation. Ofc. Abele determined that neither party was going to listen to his explanation and placed the junk vehicle flyer on the window of one of the vehicles.

On May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024 your Affiant drove by 1837 Jefferson Ave. to observe if the vehicles were still on location. Your Affiant observed the Ford F150 to be backed into the driveway against the garage. This vehicle still had old series NE license plates on it that were expired. Your Affiant observed the White Dodge Ram Truck to be in the driveway parked facing the F150. This vehicle had Texas plates on it. Your Affiant further observed a homemade trailer that did not have a registration plate attached to the Dodge Ram.

While your Affiant was photographing these two vehicles from the public street Brian Brown pulled up and parked in front of his house. Brian Brown had several children in the vehicle at the time. He rolled down his window and began yelling and cussing at your Affiant reinforcing his unwillingness to remedy the violations.

On May 19, 2024 at approximately 1245 hours your Affiant drove by 1837 Jefferson Ave. and observed the condition of the vehicles had not changed.

Your Affiant checked for a hobbyist permit to be issued to 1837 Jefferson Ave. and found that none had been issued as of May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

The above does constitute grounds of probable cause for the issuance of a Search Warrant for 1837 Jefferson Ave., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, for the following items:

White 2010 Ford F150, Nebraska License Plate, WXV048 expired 3/2023,  
VIN: 1FTMF1CW4AKA19050

White Dodge Ram, Texas License Plate, BMD9933 expired 12/2019

Black Truck box homemade trailer, No License plate.

Any vehicles remaining on the property that have been unregistered for more than 30 days.

All vehicles are located on the property at 1837 Jefferson Ave. Lincoln Lancaster County, Nebraska.

Your AFFIANT requests authorization to measure, photograph, video tape and seize the aforementioned items.



