





Emily Rakoczy, a certified law enforcement officer for the Lincoln Police Department, being first duly sworn upon oath deposes and states that your Affiant is currently involved in the investigation of Unlawful Intrusion, 28-311.08(4), occurring between March 17th 2022 to August 30th 2022 in Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

Affiant’s Background

Your Affiant has been a law enforcement officer since 2019. Your Affiant has received basic academy training and additional training through the Lincoln Police Department. Affiant has experience in conducting criminal investigations including misdemeanor and felony offenses.

This Affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of securing a search warrant. Your Affiant has not set forth every fact known regarding this investigation. The facts contained in this Affidavit are based in part on the investigation that your Affiant has conducted or information provided to your Affiant by other law enforcement officers.

Case Facts

On November 24, 2022 R.W. a 35 year-old resident of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska contacted police to report that a nude image of her was being shared online. R.W. reported that her ex-boyfriend, Benjamin Armitage, sent her a screenshot of several Facebook posts. One of the Facebook posts was from the account “Jadyn Rose” and contained two images of R.W. One was of her face and the other was of her body. In this second image she is completely naked and her pubic area is clearly visible. The post listed R.W.’s first and last name, phone number, email address and general area where she lived. The post mentioned R.W. would “Fuck your man at no cost”. R.W. explained the account belonged to Jadyn Prather, who also used to date Benjamin Armitage. R.W. also explained she sent these images to Benjamin while they were dating. The account “Jadyn Rose” account was later determined to be <https://www.facebook.com/jadyn.rose.927>.

Police then contacted Benjamin. Benjamin said he used to be in a relationship with Jady. Benjamin said he first saw the posts in August 2022 and reported them to Facebook. Benjamin provided contact information for Jady. He later stated the images had been posted on Facebook in March 2022.

On November 25, 2022 R.W. re-contacted police with additional information. She provided a message chain between her and Jady from March 18th, 2022 in which Jady states “I guess if I have to go crazy and share to adult sites the skanks photos/videos I find in his [Benjamin] phone every now and then I guess it is what it is.”

On November 26, 2022 police contacted Jady at phone number 402-890-0750. She was unable to speak at that time and hung up.

On December 2nd, 2022 police submitted a preservation request to Facebook for the account <https://www.facebook.com/jady.rose.927> requesting records be preserved from March 17th, 2022 to August 30, 2022. A subpoena was also sent requesting subscriber information.

On January 5, 2023 police received subscriber records for the Facebook account <https://www.facebook.com/jady.rose.927>. The phone number associated with the account was found to be 402-890-0750 and the email address associated with the account was jadyprather0630@gmail.com.

On January 19, 2023 R.W. sent police screenshots of text messages she had received from Benjamin. The messages were an exchange between Benjamin and Jady. In those screenshots Jady was upset because “You pressed charges for that post on my Facebook”.

On December 26, 2023 Jady was contacted by Lincoln Police and cited for Unlawful Intrusion. She declined to make any statements about this case.

Facebook allows users to upload photos and videos, which may include any metadata such as locations that the user transmitted when uploading the photo or video. Facebook has a chat feature that allows users to send and receive instant messages through Facebook Messenger. Facebook also has Video and Voice Calling features, and although Facebook does not record the calls themselves, it does keep records of the date of each call. Facebook also has a Marketplace feature, which allows users to post free classified ads.

In addition to the applications described above, Meta Platforms, Inc. also provides its users with access to thousands of other applications ("apps") on the Meta Platforms, Inc. platforms. When a Facebook user accesses or uses one of these applications, an update about that user's access or use of that application may appear on the user's profile page.

Meta Platforms, Inc. also retains Internet Protocol ("IP") logs for a given user ID or IP address. These logs may contain information about the actions taken by the user ID or IP address on Facebook, including information about the type of action, the date and time of the action, and the user ID and IP address associated with the action. Meta Platforms, Inc. also uses "cookies" to store and receive identifiers and other information on computers, phones, and other devices. Other technologies, including data stored from the user's web browser or device, identifiers associated with the user's device, and other software, are used for similar purposes. "Cookies" are defined in this context as small pieces of text used to store information on web browsers.

As explained herein, information stored in connection with a Facebook account may provide crucial evidence of the "who, what, why, when, where, and how" of the criminal conduct under investigation. In your Affiant's training and experience, a Facebook user's

IP log, stored electronic communications, and other data retained by Meta Platforms, Inc., can indicate who has used or controlled the Facebook account. This “user attribution” evidence is analogous to the search for “indicia of occupancy” while executing a search warrant at a residence.

Although not primarily designed as an email communications platform, Facebook does allow users or anyone visiting a user’s web page to send private email communications. Additionally, “Precision Location” information includes information about the location of the target Facebook account.
