

ORDER TO PRODUCE IDENTIFYING PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Detharoun Sihakhom

TO: Jessica Drager, and other law enforcement officers of the Lincoln Police Department

WHEREAS, Jessica Drager has filed an Affidavit before the undersigned Judge of the District Court of Lancaster County, Nebraska, a copy of which Affidavit is attached hereto and made a part hereof, the court finds that for purposes of this Order the facts set forth in said Affidavit are true, and said facts and the evidence adduced constitute grounds and probable cause for the issuance of an Order to Produce Identifying Physical Characteristics. The Court further finds and orders as follows:

- 1. That the offense of robbery is the subject of said Affidavit referred to above
- 2. That there is probable cause to believe that the offense of robbery has been committed.
- 3. That there is probable cause to believe that Detharoun Sihakhom committed said offense.
- 4. That Identifying Physical Characteristics Sought is a sample of his DNA in the form of DNA buccal swabs That Detharoun Sihakhom has refused, to voluntarily provide the identifying physical characteristics sought.
- 5. That Detharoun Sihakhom is the individual who may be detained for obtaining such identifying physical characteristics.
- 6. That Jessica Drager and other officers of the Lincoln Police Department are the peace officers authorized to obtain such identifying physical characteristics and to effectuate any detention which may be necessary to obtain the same.
- 7. That Detharoun Sihakhom will be under no legal obligation to submit to any interrogation or to make any statement during the period of his appearance.
- 8. That such identifying physical characteristics may be obtained at the Washington County Jail 444 South 16<sup>th</sup> Street, Blair, Washington County, Nebraska.

- 9. That Detharoun Sihakhom shall appear at the Washington County Jail 444 South 16<sup>th</sup> Street Blair, Washington County, Nebraska, at such date and time as is designated by Jessica Drager for the purpose of obtaining the above-mentioned identifying physical characteristics.
- 10. That if Detharoun Sihakhom fails to comply with the request of said Jessica Drager, the said Detharoun Sihakhom shall be guilty of contempt of court and be punished accordingly.
- 11. That Detharoun Sihakhom shall be required to stay no longer than one (1) hour for the purpose of Jessica Drager obtaining the above-mentioned identifying physical characteristics.
- 12. That this Order shall remain in force and effect for a period of fifteen (15) days only.
- 13. That a copy of this Order shall be served upon Detharoun Sihakhom.
- 14. That a Return of this Order shall be made within 30 days after the identification procedures have been carried out, setting forth the type of identifying physical characteristics obtained. If the Order is not executed, a Return shall be filed within 30 days stating the same.

THEREFORE, you are commanded to search the said Detharoun Sihakhom to produce the aforementioned identifying physical characteristics which constitutes evidence that a criminal offense has been committed, and to seize the same.

AFFIDAVIT FOR AFFIDAVIT FOR ORDER TO PRODUCE IDENTIFYING PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

COMES NOW, Investigator Jessica Drager of the Lincoln Police Department, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and states as follows:

- 1. Your AFFIANT was assigned to investigate a robbery that occurred in the alley behind 1212 D Street Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.
- 2. Your AFFIANT has reviewed reports of other peace officers involved in the investigation of this Robbery and has conducted additional follow-up into the investigation of the incident. According to the information that your AFFIANT obtained:

On April 17, 2024, at 22:51 hours Officer James Short with the Lincoln Police Department was dispatched to the alley behind 1212 D Street Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska on a check welfare. Dispatch had received a call from an unknown person who could hear a male yelling help and to call the police from the alley. Officer Short made contact with Keven Leon DOB: 05-21-1998 a short time later at U-Stop 610 South 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln. Lancaster County, Nebraska after he called in stating he was 'jumped'. Leon reported he was parked behind 1030 South 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska waiting to meet up with someone. Leon said he wasn't getting a response, so he started to drive away but decided to drive down the alley behind 1212 D Street, Lincoln Lancaster County, Nebraska one last time in case the person he was going to meet up with reached out.

During this drive down the alley Leon stated an unknown Asian male waived him down and approached his Jeep. The male asked Leon if he wanted to buy something to which Leon said no. Leon said he started to drive away but went slow because he was on his cellular telephone. Leon stated suddenly, the male that had waived him down had entered the passenger side of his Jeep. Leon said

the male told him 'I have a gun get out'. The male then proceeded to punch Leon in the head multiple times with a closed fist that caused visible injuries. The male continued to try to push Leon out of his Jeep while continuing to assault him. The unknown male kept yelling 'get out' and 'get the fuck out.' Leon stated the struggle continued for a while until he was able to push the male out of his Jeep and Leon sped away from the area to make the report. Leon stated the male pulled off Leon's shirt during the altercation and when Leon pushed the male out of the Jeep the male took Leon's shirt with him.

On April 19, 2024, Leon met with your Affiant for a formal interview. Leon informed Your Affiant that he was looking through his Jeep following the incident and located a clear meth pipe between his passenger seat and center console. This meth pipe was turned over to Your Affiant and tagged into property. Based on Your Affiants training and experience, meth pipes are utilized by users to ingest methamphetamines orally.

Video was obtained from 1030 South 12<sup>th</sup> Street Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska that shows the incident. The video depicts what Leon reported. Stills from the video were obtained and a Crime stoppers bulletin was created. On May 20, 2024, Deputy Stankoski with the Pawnee County Sheriff's Office called into the Lincoln Police department stating the person from the created Crime Stoppers bulletin for this case was Detharoun Sihakhom DOB: 01-02-1971. Deputy Standkoski stated he was part of the arrest team for Sihakhom when he was arrested on May 15, 2024, for an Otoe County Case.

On May 31, 2024, Your Affiant attempted to interview Sihakhom at the Washington County Jail in Blair, Washington County, Nebraska. Sihakhom asked for an attorney and denied consent for his DNA. Sihakhom's DNA is needed to be compared to the meth pipe that was left in Leon's Jeep.

3. Your AFFIANT knows that buccal DNA swabs are a way of producing non-testimonial identification evidence regarding the person responsible for the Robbery described herein. The identifying physical characteristics sought from Detharoun Sihakom is a sample of his DNA in the form of DNA buccal swabs. The procurement of these identifying physical characteristics is likely to contribute evidence to the further identification of Detharoun Sihakom as being the person responsible for the Robbery herein.

The identifying physical characteristics sought can be obtained from Detharoun Sihakom at the Washington County Jail, 444 South 16<sup>th</sup> Street, Blair,

Washington County, Nebraska and should require a detention not to exceed one (1) hour.

AFFIANT further states that there is probable cause to believe that Detharoun Sihakhom is responsible for Robbery as described herein, and in violation of the laws of the State of Nebraska.

4. Your AFFIANT has been advised by Detharoun that he has refused to voluntarily provide a DNA sample via buccal swabs.

Further your affiant saith not.
