Chris Champoux, being first duly sworn upon oath deposes and states that he is an Investigator for the Lincoln Police Department, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. AFFIANT states he is currently involved in the investigation of a Child Aduse, Statute 28-707, occurring on June 4th / June 5th, 2024, at 5043 Walker Ave, Lincoln, Lancaster County Nebraska. AFFIANT has reviewed case reports regarding this investigation prepared by other involved Law Enforcement Officers.

Affiant's Background

Your affiant has been a police officer for the Lincoln Police Department since 1997.

Your affiant has been a police officer for the Lincoln Police Department to incl.

Lincoln Police Department to incl. human trafficking, child enticement, and pornography. Your Affiant has training and experience in conducting criminal investigations.

This Affidavit is submitted in support of a search warrant. Since this Affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of securing a search warrant, your Affiant has not set forth every fact known to me regarding this investigation. The statements contained in this Affidavit are based in part on the investigation that your Affiant has conducted, and information provided to your Affiant by other law enforcement officers verbally, and through written reports.

## Case Facts

On June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at 4:01 AM, the reporting party (victim's mother) contacted the Emergency Communications Center requesting medical attention for her five-year-old daughter (K.C.R.). K.C.R. was brought to the reporting party by an acquaintance (Jonn Wesley Graves d.o.b. 04/05/1981) in a lethargic state and in need of medical attention. K.C.R. and her seven-year-old sister K.R. were subsequently transported via ambulance to an area hospital and received treatment for ingestion of an unknown substance.

K.C.R. and K.C.'s eight-year-old brother T.R. reported to his mother that just after dark on June 4th, 2024, John Graves came to their residence while their mother was sleeping

C4-048705 Affidavit Page 1 of 4 Revised 10-11-2023 and convinced K.C.R. and K.C. to come with him to his residence by offering them an opportunity to play with "play-doh". John Graves has an address listed in Lincoln Police records management system on recent reports as 5043 Walker Ave. in Lincoln. John Graves has also listed 5043 Walker Ave. in Lincoln as his address in his disclosure information to the Nebraska Sex Offender Registry. An unknown amount of time elapsed before the reporting party woke to discover her daughters missing and was advised what happened by T.R. The reporting party then began walking towards John Graves' house and met John Graves on the way, and observed Graves carrying K.C.R.

K.C.R., K.C., and T.R. were subsequently interviewed by Lincoln Police Officers as well as a Forensic Interview Specialist. During these interviews, K.C.R. and K.C. both explained that John was at their residence when their mother was sleeping. Both victims said that John then took them to his residence and gave them toys and candy. K.C. stated that when at Johns residence, he locked the door so they couldn't escape. K.C. stated that K.C.R. was sleeping while at Johns residence and John was laying with K.C.R., hugging her. K.C. said that K.C.R. found a pink beverage cup or can with striping in the yard and some medicine in the mud which she ingested, causing her to not feel well. Both K.C.R. and K.C. denied any sexual abuse. Both K.C.R. and K.C reported that John would allow them to play games on his tablet.

During his interview, T.R. said John was at their residence drinking with his mother (reporting party). T.R. said after his mother fell asleep, John left the residence with his sisters K.C.R. and K.C. T.R. said he advised his sisters not to go with John. T.R. estimated this was around midnight.

An interview with the reporting party revealed that she has never allowed her children to go to John's residence. She added that John never babysat her children, and she has never given John any idea, permission, or perception that she would allow him to remove any of the children from her home outside of her presence. The reporting party advised that when she discovered the girls were missing, and T.R. told her that John took the girls, she immediately called John's cell phone three consecutive times with no answer. Following this, the reporting party left her residence on foot enroute to John's residence and encountered John and the victims on the way. The reporting party shared a text she received from John following the incident. The text was received from John's cell number (513-699-2620) on June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at 11:31AM. Your Affiant has reviewed this text message. In this text message. John apologizes to the reporting party for overstepping boundaries and vows to never do it again. John continues, writing that he hopes she can forgive him.

Lincoln Police Investigators conducted a criminal history check of John Graves and

 located a conviction in 2015, out of Kearney County, Nebraska for Child Enticement (Statute 38-311). In this incident, the 11 year old female victim reported that she encountered John at a local park and was invited back to John's apartment. Once at Johns apartment, the victim reports John gave her some hot chocolate which he added an unknown liquid to from a separate bottle, making the hot chocolate taste odd and minty. The victim stated she was unsteady on her feet as John was teaching gymnastic maneuvers. The victim reported that she asked to leave multiple times however was told she could not until she could walk straight. The victim was eventually allowed to leave and was taken to an area hospital by her mother. At the hospital, the victims' blood alcohol content was tested and showed a .110 BAC.

An additional investigation involving John and a minor was conducted by Council Bluffs Police Department in Council Bluffs, Iowa under CB22-011204 in October of 2022. In this incident, John had multiple on-line interactions with a female who he believed was 14 years old. In the on-line conversations, John made arrangements to meet the 14 year old at a Council Bluffs public park. Also included in the on-line interactions were instructions from John to delete their conversation, as well as discussion about parental consent for minors.

Lincoln Police case numbers C4-085545 and C3-006946 document disclosures from two additional victims. "K.W." and "B.W" are sisters ages 13 and 11 at the time who John had access to as he was dating their mother. K.W. and B.W. both disclosed spending the night at John's residence when their mother was not there. Both of these two victims have been forensically interviewed and disclosed that John sexually abused them at his residence. K.W. disclosed multiple incidents where John provided her cough medicine and melatonin to help her sleep. Once sleepiness ensued, John placed his hand inside K.W.'s shirt and touched her breast with his hand. K.W. also disclosed that while under the influence of the sleep aids, John rubbed her buttocks on the outside of her clothing with his hand. K.W. added that on one of these incidents, John provided her with a pink "shooter" of alcohol which she consumed prior to going to bed. B.W. disclosed that on one occasion, she was spending the night alone with John at his residence. She disclosed that John placed his hand inside her shirt and touched her breast after while she was resting on the floor. B.W. explained that on this incident, John offered her melatonin and alcohol, however she refused. She added that John also gave her cough syrup which she consumed but then vomited. K.W. advised that she has exchanged text messages with John via "messenger". K.W. reports threatening messages to her and her family. K.W. advised that she observed John use a tablet to send and receive messages.
