WHEREAS, Jesse Tenney #1821, has filed an Affidavit before the undersigned Judge of the County Court of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, and said written Affidavit, having been duly considered, the court finds that the facts set forth in said Affidavit are true, and that those facts do constitute grounds and probable cause for the issuance of a Search Warrant.

THEREFORE, you are commanded to search the premises of 2748 Sumner St., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska for the following items:

Any and all controlled substance, including but not limited to methamphetamine, marijuana, drug paraphernalia items commonly used for the ingestion of controlled substances; drug paraphernalia items commonly used for the preparation and distribution of controlled substances including, but not limited to scales, plastic bags, film canisters, tin foil, or other packaging containers such as vials and plastic wrap: any documentary evidence relating to the source of the controlled substance including, but not limited to customer lists, account sheets, ledgers, notes, or diaries; receipts; maps; cellular telephones and any other electronic storage devices that could be used in the communication and/storage of information of the sale of controlled substances; any proceeds directly attributable to the sale of controlled substances including, but not limited to United States currency, bank accounts, property, or other financial records, permission to photograph the same; any evidence of occupancy or ownership; and authorizing and directing seizure of the same. Surveillance equipment, including but not limited to cameras, monitors, cables, and recording devices. Any and all firearms, ammunition or firearms related accessories.

The court has granted permission to use any and all measures necessary to access the contents of any safes or any lockable storage containers.

Law enforcement is authorized to measure, photograph, video tape and seize the aforementioned items.

Investigator Jesse Tenney, being first duly sworn upon oath deposes and states that he is a Investigator for the Lincoln Police Department, Lancaster County, Nebraska. Your AFFIANT has been a Police Officer with the Lincoln Police Department since 2018. Your AFFIANT is currently assigned to the Lincoln/Lancaster County Narcotics Task Force (hereafter "LLCNTF") as a Narcotics Investigator. AFFIANT further states he is currently involved in the investigation of POSSESS CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE 28-416(3) (F4) involving BRENNON M BUSKE (DOB: 03-06-1988) occurring at 2748 Sumner St., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. As part of the investigation, AFFIANT has consulted with other involved law enforcement and reviewed case reports.

The residence of 2748 Sumner St., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska is located on the north side of Sumner St. between S 27th St and S 28t St. The residence has white siding and trim. The residence displays '2748' in black lettering on the front of the porch on the south side of the residence.

Facts:

On 10-26-2023 Officer Lawrence #1825 received information from a source of information of unknown reliability that BRENNON M BUSKE (DOB: 03-06-1988) is a convicted felon and has multiple firearms inside of his residence at 2748 Sumner St., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

On 06-03-2024 your AFFIANT was conducting routine patrol in an unmarked police vehicle with Investigator Eirich #1620. Your AFFIANT observed a gray 2001 Chevrolet Tahoe (NE# ASA143) traveling westbound on Sumner St from S 28th St and to park on the street in front of 2748 Sumner St., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. Your AFFIANT ran the affixed license plate via the LPD RMS and observed JILLIAN C RITCHIE (DOB: 12-23-1990) to be the registered owner. Your AFFIANT observed for the current driver of the

vehicle to be a white male and observed via the LPD RMS for Buske to be a known associate of Ritchie. Your AFFIANT observed that both parties have given LPD officers 2748 Sumner St. as their current address.

Your AFFIANT confirmed Buske to be the driver of the vehicle as he exited the vehicle and stood next to it via his most recent Lancaster County bookin photo. Your AFFIANT checked Buske's NE OLN status and found it to be revoked as of 03-08-2023 for 15 years for a conviction of Drive Under the Influence $.15 - 3^{rd}$ Offense. Your AFFIANT and Investigator Eirich exited their unmarked police vehicle with badges of office on display and contacted Buske outside of the vehicle.

Upon seeing investigators approaching, Buske removed a shoulder strap bag from his person and threw it into the vehicle. Buske was taken into custody due to driving during revocation. In accordance with LPD policy, the vehicle was towed. Prior to tow an inventory search of the vehicle was conducted. Inside of the bag that Buske had been carrying, along with prescription pill bottles in his name, your AFFIANT located a glass vial of suspected methamphetamine (approximately 2g) and two glass pipes with suspected methamphetamine residue (positive pretest for presence of amphetamines/methamphetamine).

Your AFFIANT contacted Ritchie at the front door of the residence to notify her of the vehicle being towed. Upon Ritchie exiting the residence, your AFFIANT observed a strong odor of burnt marijuana coming from inside the residence. Ritchie informed your AFFIANT that there was marijuana and paraphernalia inside of the residence. Your AFFIANT asked Ritchie about the possibility of Buske having firearms and more methamphetamine inside the residence. Ritchie reported that Buske has recently talked to her about firearms, but denied knowing if he has any inside of the residence. Ritchie reported that Buske has a bedroom in the northeast corner of the residence that she does not go in, and so she would not know if there were firearms in that room.

Ritchie retrieved two large dogs from inside the residence and allowed investigators to conduct a security sweep to verify that there were no other people in the residence. During this security sweep investigators observed suspected drug paraphernalia, including a glass marijuana bong.

Your AFFIANT checked Buske's criminal history and found him to be a convicted felon due to a conviction of REFUSE TO SUBMIT TO TEST W/ 2 PRIOR CONVICTIONS 60-6197.03(6) (F3A) ON 04-13-2022 in Lancaster County, Nebraska.

The above does constitute grounds of probable cause for the issuance of a Search Warrant for 2748 Sumner St., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, for the following items:

Any and all controlled substance, including but not limited to methamphetamine, marijuana, and drug paraphernalia items commonly used for the ingestion of controlled substances; drug paraphernalia items commonly used for the preparation and distribution of controlled substances including, but not limited to scales, plastic bags, film canisters, tin foil, or other packaging containers such as vials and plastic wrap: any documentary evidence relating to the source of the controlled substance including, but not limited to customer lists, account sheets, ledgers, notes, or diaries; receipts; maps; cellular telephones and any other electronic storage devices that could be used in the communication and/storage of information of the sale of controlled substances; any proceeds directly attributable to the sale of controlled substances including, but not limited to United States currency, bank accounts, property, or other financial records, permission to photograph the same; any evidence of occupancy or ownership; and authorizing and directing seizure of the same. Surveillance equipment, including but not limited to cameras, monitors, cables, and recording devices. Any and all firearms, ammunition or firearms related accessories.

Your AFFIANT requests permission to access any safe, lockable storage containers or any other vessel, which could reasonably contain controlled substances, or any other evidence sought by any means necessary.

Your AFFIANT requests authorization to measure, photograph, video tape and seize the aforementioned items.

Your AFFIANT further states that public interests require that officers serving this warrant need not knock or announce their presence prior to entry due to the fact that investigators are already on location following the security sweep of the residence.

Your AFFIANT states the public interest requires that the requested search warrant not be restricted to daytime service and that it may be served any time for the fact that investigators have already seized the residence and that nighttime will

soon be upon us as it is currently 1930 hours at the time your AFFIANT is authoring this search warrant.
